CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

All athletes must sign and abide by the Code of Conduct Agreement while training, traveling, or competing as a member of the CHAWP team.

WE AGREE THAT:

- 1. On the trip, nightly curfews will be observed.
- 2. All meetings, training sessions, etc., will be attended and athletes are expected to be on time.
- 3. Physical damage occurring in a room will be paid for by the registered occupant(s).
- 4. There will be no unacceptable behavior. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - a. Committing an act, which would be considered an offense under the laws of the United States, the host countries or United States Water Polo.
 - b. Gross misbehavior and unsportsmanlike conduct.
 - c. Disrespect to coaching staff

Persons present while any of these prohibited activities occur must leave immediately or will be considered a participant by choice. Any person observing or having knowledge of any activity, which may result in serious bodily harm, must report such activity to the team staff immediately.

Violations of the preceding may entail, depending upon the circumstances, the following:

- 1. Full or partial restriction of movement or participation in activities on the trip.
- 2. Removal from the team and sent home at parent's expense.
- 3. Assessment of fine to cover any damage caused by the player.
- 4. Any combination of the above.
